

# Phase Two of your new bus network launches on December 5<sup>th</sup>...

## ...including:

- More buses to the High Street in Newport City Centre
- Increased frequencies in Caerleon, Moorland Park and Spytty Park
- A new 44 service for Lliswerry and Nash College
- A new 28B service for Caerleon serving Roman Way and Ponthir Road
- New clockwise and anticlockwise services in Malpas and an extended 19 service to better serve areas such as Pilton Vale and Oliphant Circle
- Improved timetable leaflets with full route descriptions so you know where your bus goes

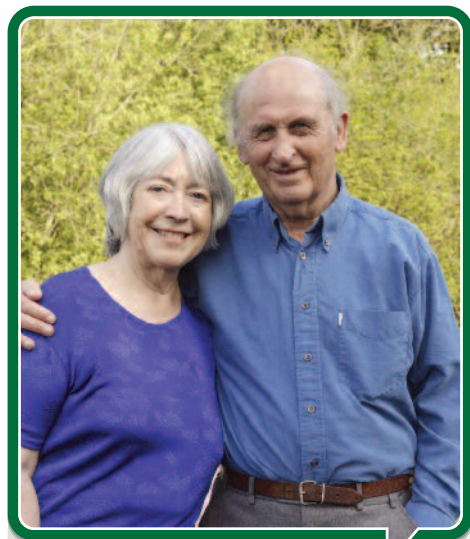

# What you told us and how we've listened



**You told us that there aren't enough buses in the Caerleon area so...**

We're increasing the frequency of our Caerleon 27 and 28 services from every 15 minutes to every 12 minutes giving you more opportunities to travel to and from the town.

**You told us that there aren't enough ways of getting to and from Nash College or Liswerry so...**

We're introducing a new 44 service specifically to serve these two areas.

**You told us that some areas of Malpas weren't being served by our buses so...**

We're introducing clockwise and anticlockwise services to better serve areas such as Pilton Vale and extending the service 19 to Oliphant Circle.

**You told us that buses are often full in Caerleon so...**

We're introducing a new 28B service which will serve Roman Way and Ponthir Road and not stop in the local university campus.

**You told us that our buses didn't provide enough opportunities to stop in the High Street so...**

From December 5 services 17, 18, 19, 27, 28B, 37, 42, 43 and 44 will all include stops in the High Street.



**You told us that our timetables didn't have enough information about the routes they served so...**

We're introducing new timetables over the coming months with full route descriptions so you know where your buses go.

**You told us that there aren't enough buses in the Moorland Park and Spytty Park area so...**

We're increasing the frequency of our 42 and 43 services from every 15 minutes to every 12 minutes giving you more opportunities to catch the bus to and from Moorland Park and Spytty Park when you want to.
